To be eligible for prestigious CVCC awards and to have your DXCC TOTALS immortalized in Cyberspace, your end-of-year totals needed to be updated by the end of January, 2004, but running totals can be added anytime. As always, exceptions can be made for late submittals if you have a plausible or clever original excuse, like "my cat ate my mouse and I couldn't e-mail my totals in time". 


