In accordance with the CVCC constitution the election of officers for the 2013-14 year will be during the April meeting. We need a nomination committee to find volunteers to fill the positions. Please consider serving as an officer, committee chairman or committee member for the upcoming fiscal year.

CVCC DUES 2013-2014

From the CVCC Constitution:

Annual dues for the upcoming year will be established at the November meeting each year. Additional family members living at the same address or full time students shall pay one-half the annual dues. Dues are due on January 1st and not later than the March regular meeting each year. Failure to pay within that period shall be cause for removal from the active membership rolls. A member thus removed from the active membership rolls may reacquire active membership by paying the current year dues in full any time during that calendar year. Failure to pay by December 31st will result in termination of membership. A member thus terminated may rejoin at a later date as a new member as outlined in the by-laws. To participate in any of the club's annual awards programs a member must have paid his current year dues by the March meeting that year. New members entering during the year will have their current year dues prorated as follows:

Entering January to March – 100% Entering April to June – 75% Entering July to September – 50% Entering October to December – 25%

Dues are \$25.00!
